

Auckland Monthly Housing Update

September 2017

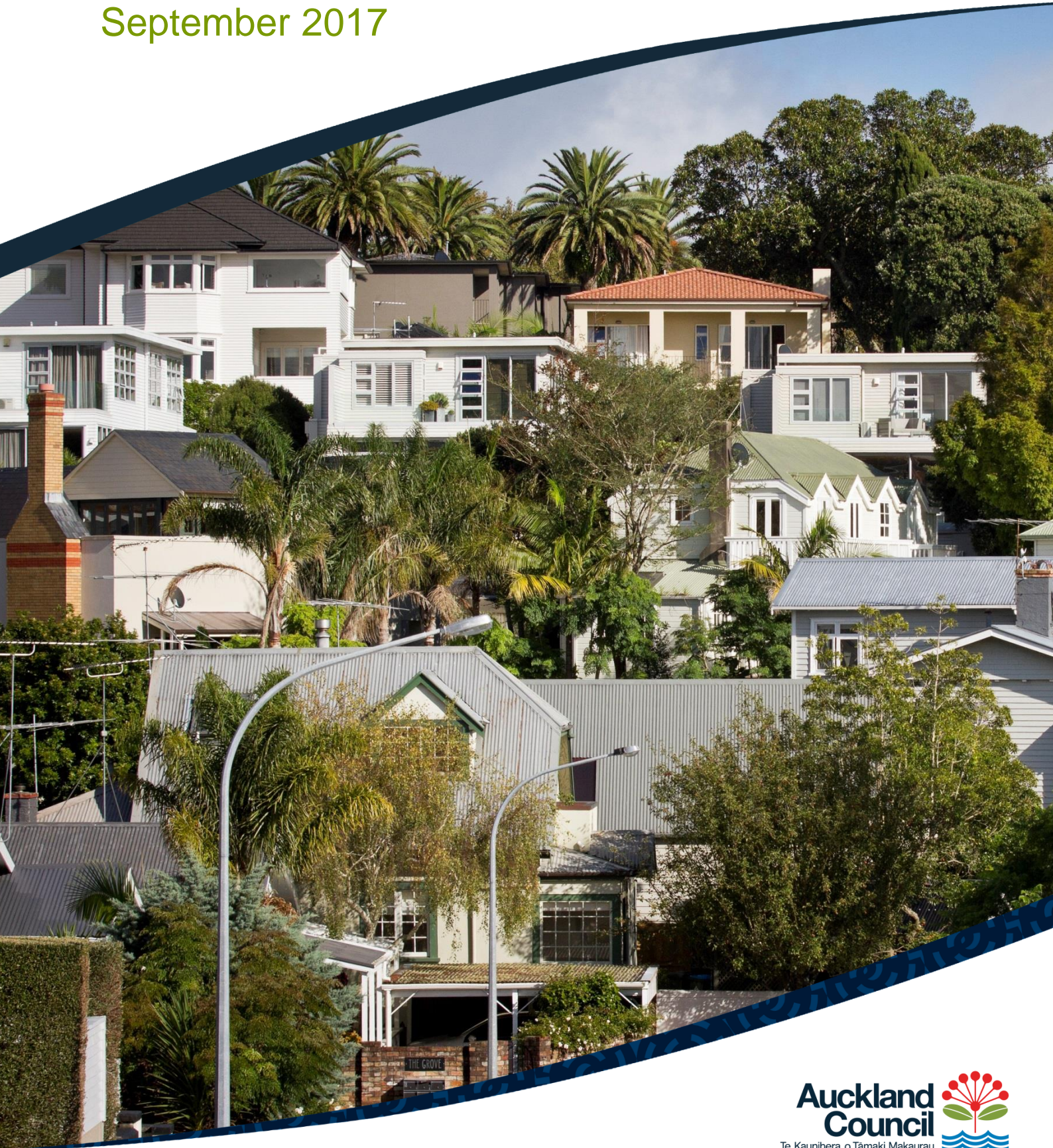


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1. Summary

Produced by the Auckland Council Research and Evaluation Unit (RIMU), the Auckland Monthly Housing Update brings together a number of significant Auckland housing related statistics.

The report includes:

- dwellings – consented, by type, and with CCCs issued
- residential parcels – created, and inside Metropolitan Urban Limits (MUL)
- dwellings in pipeline
- permanent and long-term migration – net change
- median residential sales price.

2. Highlights

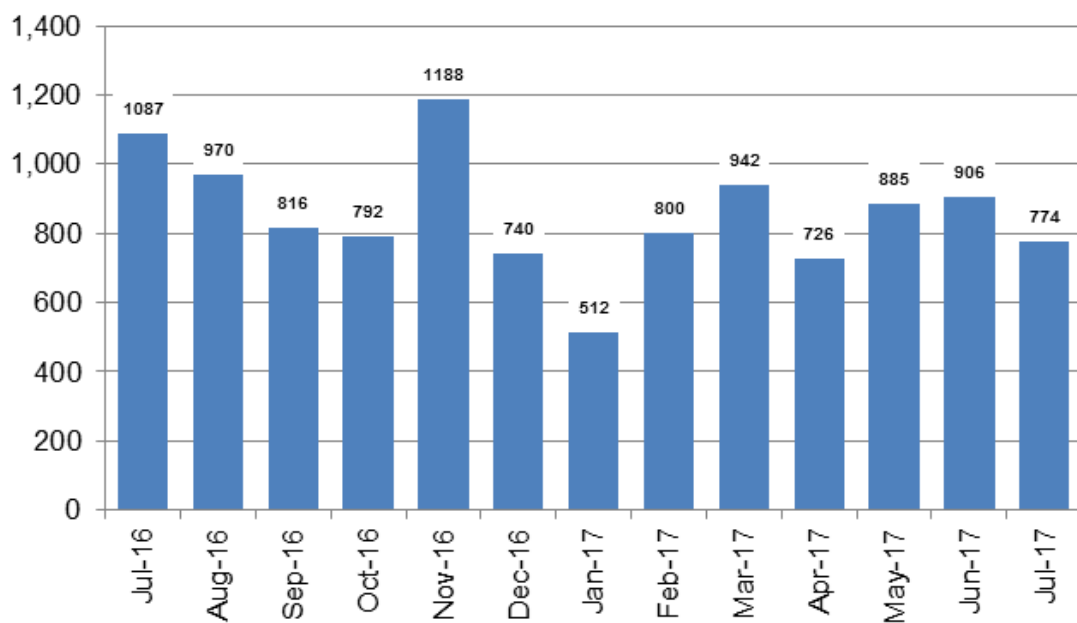
- 774 dwellings were consented in July 2017.
- In the year ending July 2017, a total of 10,051 dwellings were consented in Auckland.
- 57 per cent of new dwellings consented were houses, 25 per cent were apartments and 18 per cent were townhouses, flats, units, retirement units, or another type of dwelling.
- 75 per cent of dwellings consented in July 2017 were inside the MUL. Over the past year 76 per cent of new dwellings consented were inside the 2010 MUL.
- 652 dwellings were 'completed' by having a Code Compliance Certificate (CCC) issued.
- In the year ending July 2017, a total of 7056 dwellings had a CCC issued.
- 864 new residential parcels were created in August 2017, with 493 being inside Special Housing Areas (SHA).
- In the past 12 months 7498 new residential parcels were created; that was an average of 625 each month.
- Of the new residential parcels created in the year ending August 2017, 57 per cent were inside the 2010 MUL.
- International migration to Auckland in the 12 months ending July 2017 was 36,753. International net migration to Auckland increased 15 per cent from the previous 12 months.
- Median residential sales price in July 2017 was \$830,000, an increase of \$5,000 compared to July 2016, or an increase of 1 per cent.

3. Dwellings consented

In July 2017, 774 dwelling consents were issued, which saw a total of 10,051 consents issued for the past 12 months.

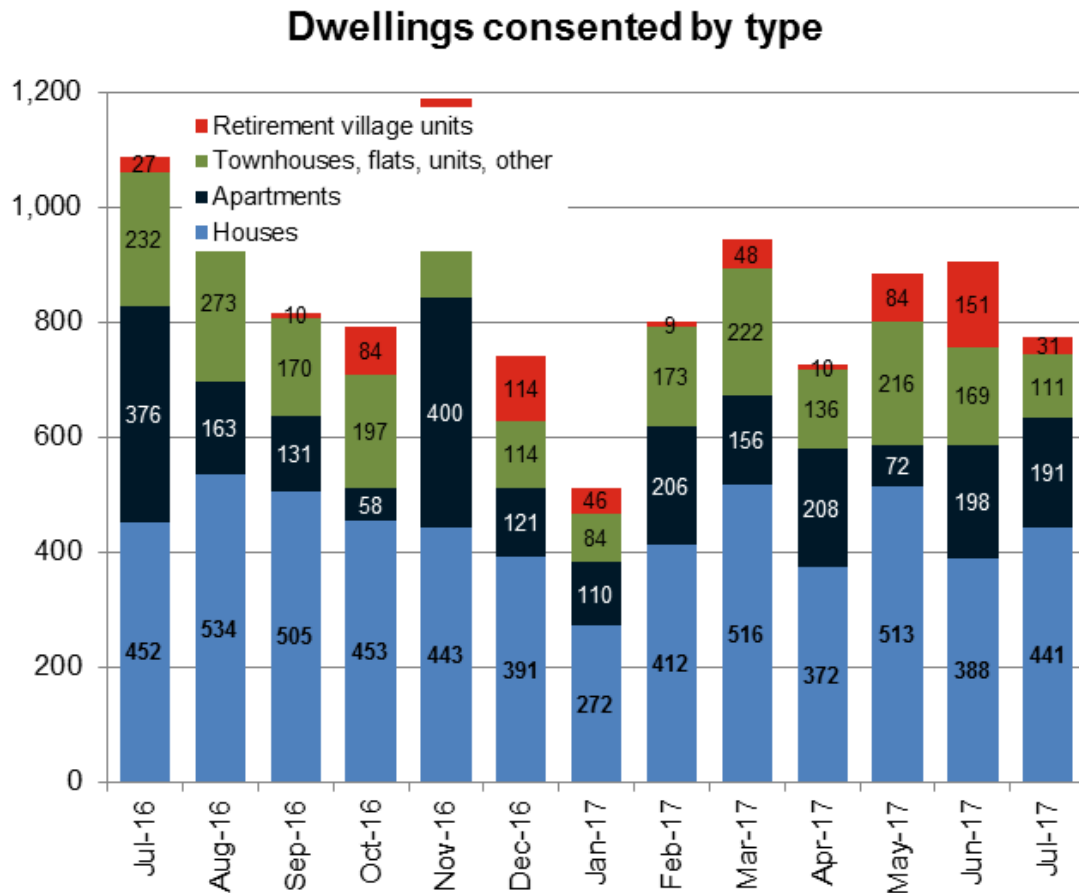

4. Dwellings consented by type

Of all the dwelling consents issued, 441 consents issued were for houses. A total of 302 consents were issued for townhouses, flats, units and apartments.

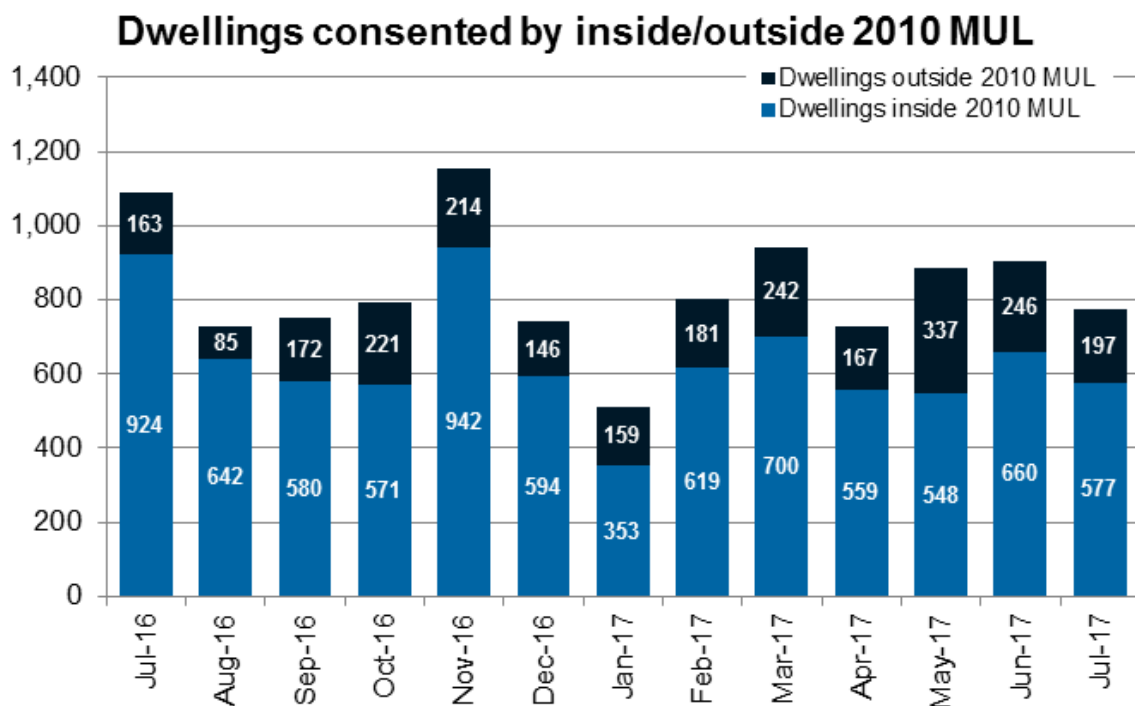

5. Dwellings consented inside 2010 MUL

In July 2017, 577 dwellings consented were inside the 2010 MUL, and the proportion for the last 12 months was 76%.

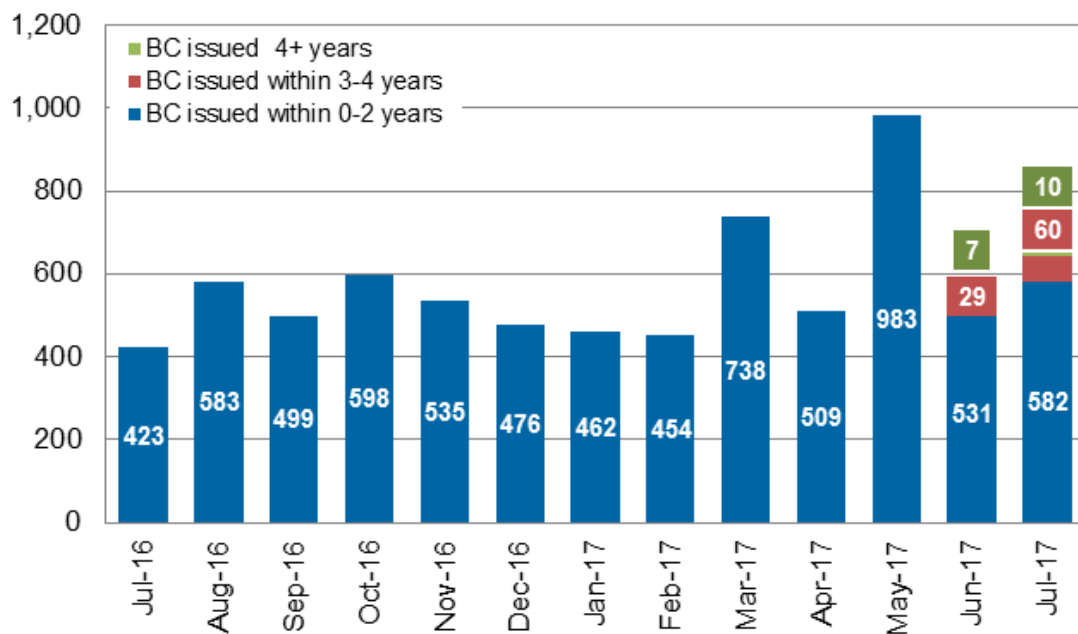

6. Dwellings with CCCs issued (completions)

652 dwelling units had received CCCs in July 2017. 89% of the CCCs were issued to dwelling units that had building consents granted within the past two years.

Dwellings with CCCs issued

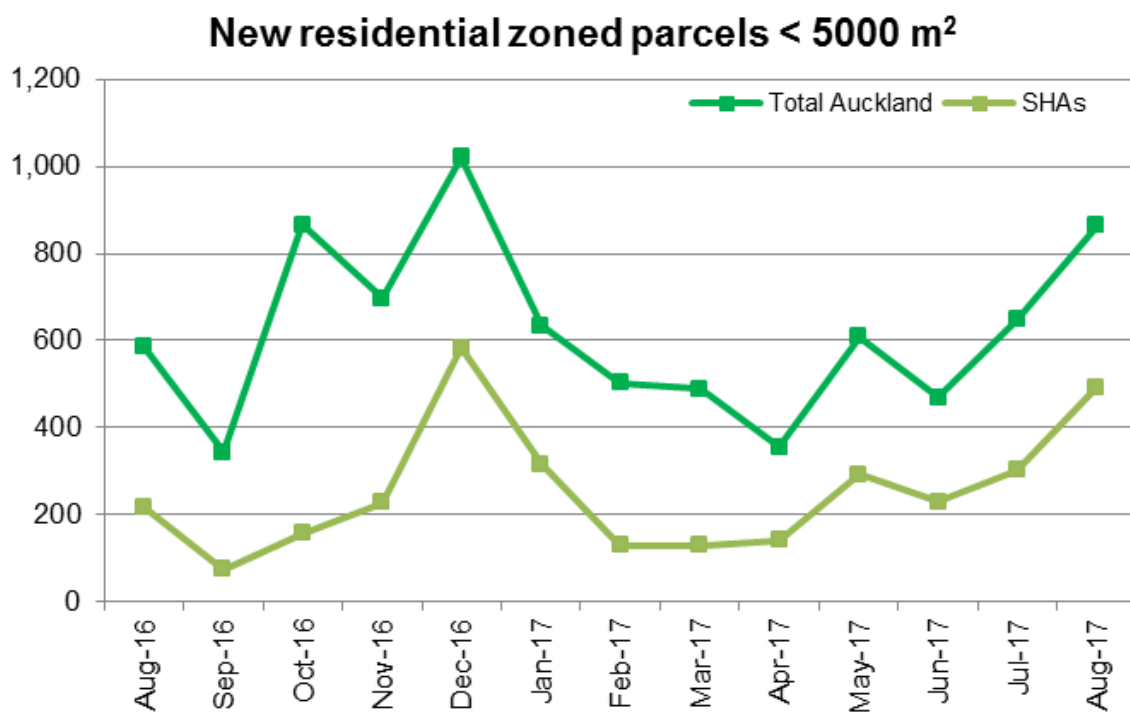

7. Residential parcels created

In August 2017, the total number of residential parcels created was 864. 493 of the residential parcels created were inside Special Housing Areas.

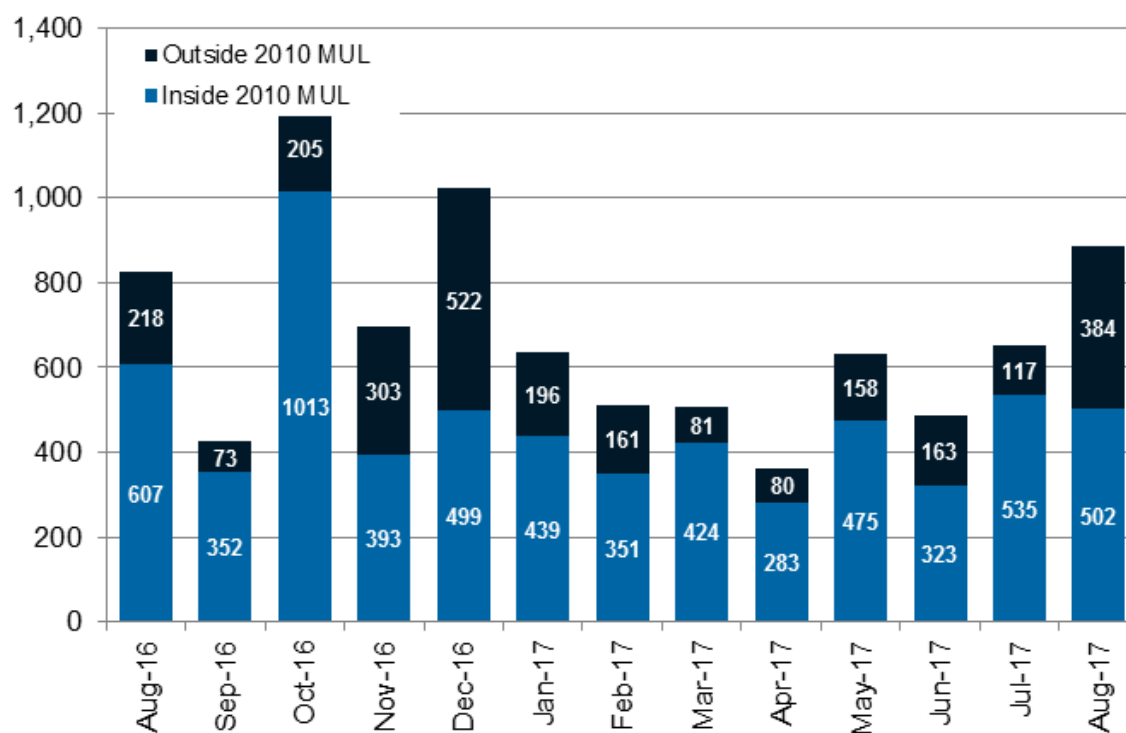

8. Residential parcels inside 2010 MUL

57% of new residential parcels created in August 2017 were inside the 2010 MUL. Over the past 12 months, 5589 of 8032 residential parcels, or 70%, were created inside the 2010 MUL.

Residential parcels by inside/outside 2010 MUL

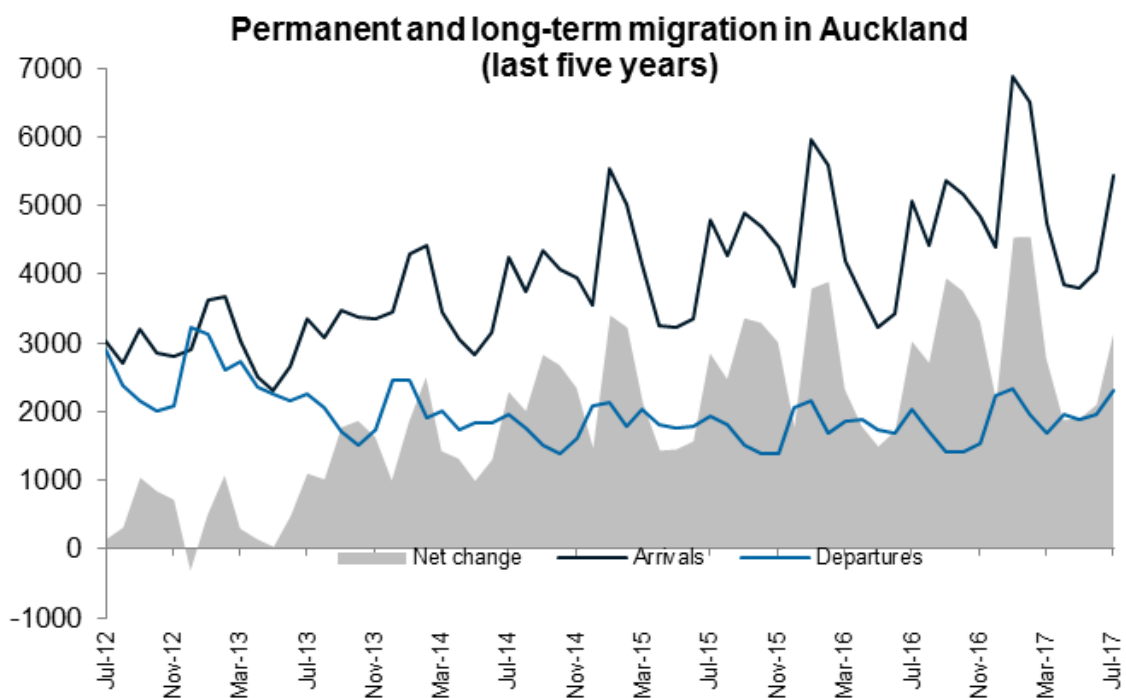

9. Permanent and long-term migration – net change

Net migration to Auckland in the 12 months ending July 2017 was 36,753. The level of net migration to Auckland continues to rise steadily with an increase of 15% from the previous 12 months.

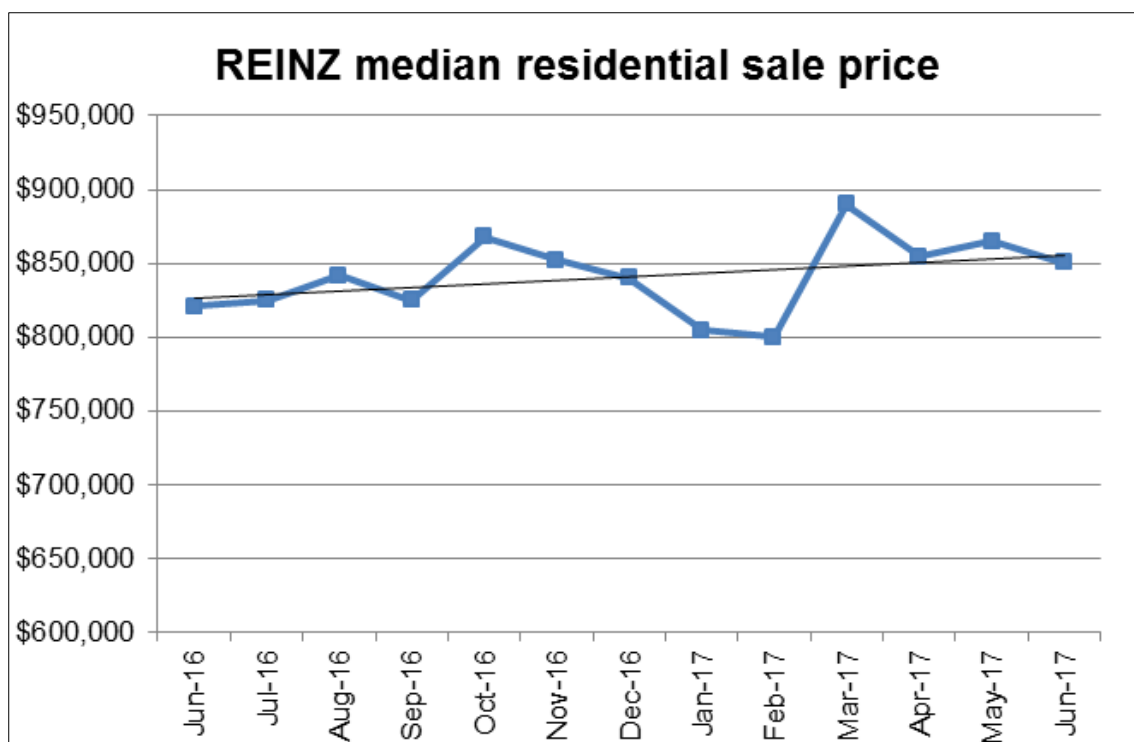

10. Median residential sales price

The median residential sales price dropped to \$830,000. It was 1% (\$5,000) higher than 12 months ago.

11. Notes on data and analysis

Dwellings consented and dwellings consented by type

Monthly building consent information is sourced from Statistics New Zealand's InfoShare online portal, which includes counts of number of new dwellings consented, by type of dwelling.

Dwellings consented inside 2010 Metropolitan Urban Limits (MUL)

Monthly data for individual building consents is supplied by Statistics New Zealand and mapped to properties by RIMU. This data is then analysed against its location relevant to the 2010 MUL.

Dwellings with CCCs issued (completions)

Monthly building consent completions data is supplied by Auckland Council Building Control. The data shows the total number of dwelling units which have had Code Compliance Certificate (CCC) issued in that month. This gives an estimation of the number of dwellings being "completed", or "released to the market".

Residential parcels created and residential parcels created inside 2010 Metropolitan Urban Limits

Parcel data is sourced from Land Information New Zealand (LINZ). A new dataset is downloaded from the LINZ Data Service by RIMU monthly. A list of parcels created in the previous month is also downloaded; this is used to extract new parcels created in the previous month. The new parcels created data is then analysed for size, the Auckland Unitary Plan (decisions version) zone it falls in and its location relevant to the 2010 MUL.

Permanent and long-term migration

Migration data is sourced from Statistics New Zealand's InfoShare online portal; arrivals, departures and net change is estimated for Auckland.

Median residential sales price

The Real Estate Institute of New Zealand (REINZ) produces monthly statistics on the median house price sales for Auckland from data provided to it by its members. This data is available on the REINZ website.
