83% of Aucklanders rated their overall life satisfaction as 7–10 (on a scale of 0–10)



Loneliness

65% of Aucklanders did not feel lonely in the last four weeks



General health status

88% of Aucklanders said their health was good, very good, or excellent



Disability

19% of Aucklanders are disabled. This is lower than the national rate of 23%*
