

Auckland has the largest population of people aged 65 and older in New Zealand, living in different local board areas.


Auckland's older population is not a homogenous group. Differences include :


- life stages

These differences affect how older people contribute and participate in their local area and wider community.




A high proportion of Kaipātiki residents are <mark>aged 25-39</mark>











of the Kaipātiki older population were born **OVERSEAS**










of older residents cannot speak English
